

Changes in the composition of the Management Board of Alior Bank S.A. and commencement of qualification procedures for the positions of President and Vice Presidents of the Bank's Management Board

Moreover, the Bank's Supervisory Board delegated Supervisory Board Member Mr. Artur Chołody to perform the duties of Vice President of the Management Board in charge of leading the Management Board, from May 15, 2024 to August 14, 2024, subject to the possibility of an early termination of the delegation.
